Note: No later than the end of the 3rd day following the qualification of candidates, the municipal clerk must conduct a drawing of lots for each office to determine the order in which the candidates' names will be placed on the Spring Election ballot. Wis. Stat. § 8.05 (1)(j). The drawing of candidate order does not require a public meeting notice. Candidates may attend, but the clerk is not required to notify or invite them to the drawing. Municipal clerks are advised to document the drawing of ballot order in writing and to not conduct the drawing alone.
