

NOTICE OF FALL CLEANUP

TOWN OF MARION

Saturday, October 4, 2025 (8 a.m. to 4 p.m.)

The Town of Marion's FALL cleanup for town residents will be held on Saturday, October 4, 2025, at the Marion Town Shop at 15833 Tower Road. Items that can be disposed of include:

- Furniture (couches, chairs, mattresses, box springs, beds, etc.).
- Plumbing (fixtures, stools, etc.).
- Some appliances.
- Most other miscellaneous items.
- TVs and/or computer monitors—**A \$25 disposal fee per TV or computer monitor will be charged.**
- TIRE DISPOSAL:
 - CAR TIRES--\$5 EACH.
 - TRUCK TIRES--\$10 EACH.
 - TRACTOR TIRES--\$20 EACH.

NO HAZARDOUS WASTES PLEASE!! THIS INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

- PAINTS & SOLVENTS (LIQUID).
- AUTOMOTIVE WASTES (MOTOR OIL, ANTIFREEZE, ETC.).
- PESTICIDES (insecticides, herbicides, fungicides, etc.).
- MERCURY-CONTAINING WASTES (thermometers, switches, fluorescent lighting, etc.).
- ELECTRONICS (computers, televisions, cell phones) – See above \$25 fee/TV or computer.
- AEROSOLS/PROPANE CYLINDERS.
- CAUSTICS/CLEANING AGENTS.
- REFRIGERANT-CONTAINING APPLIANCES.
- SOME SPECIALTY BATTERIES (e.g., lithium, nickel cadmium or button cell batteries).
- AMMUNITION.
- ASBESTOS.
- RADIOACTIVE WASTES (some home smoke detectors are classified as radioactive waste because they contain very small amounts of radioactive isotope americium).
- FLUORESCENT LIGHTS.
